
BEAD Guides Chord Flow

B.E.A.D. <u>Guides Chord Flow</u>, or BEADGCF is a phrase that helps songwriters know what chords sound best together. Each letter in BEADGCF represents a potential chord. Some examples follow. B.E.A.D. <u>Guides Chord Flow</u> is both simple and flexible. It's a great tool for songwriters

I. Any two letters next two each other are neighbors. They sound good together. E and A sound good together. So do A and D. C and F are next to each other, they sound good too.



2. The above examples are all major chords, but the same principle B.E.A.D. \underline{G} uides Chord Flow, applies to minor chords too.
